

Precinct 42 Polling Location Change

Due to a recent change of ownership and current renovations, the Old Armory Building at the Airport will not be a polling location for the Nov. 6, 2012 Nacogdoches County General Election. Registered voters who live in Precinct 42 will need to vote at the A.L. Mangham Jr. Regional Airport Pilots' Lounge instead of at the Old Armory Building at the Airport, if they choose to vote on Election Day (Nov. 6, 2012) instead of voting during Early Voting (Oct. 22, 2012 through Nov. 2, 2012) at the Courthouse Annex.

This change of venue is only expected to be temporary, and registered voters who live in Precinct 42 can expect to go back to voting at the Old Armory Building at the Airport for future elections.

While the Nacogdoches County Elections Office regrets having to make this last minute change, there shouldn't be any impact on voters because the Pilots' Lounge is on the same Airport property as the Old Armory Building, and signs will be placed on and in front of the Old Armory Building redirecting voters to the Pilots' Lounge.

We appreciate your understanding and hope to see all registered voters once voting begins.
