MINUTES Regular Session Nacogdoches City Council October 20, 2015 – 5:30 p.m. City Council Room – City Hall 202 E. Pilar Street



Those Present:

Mayor Roger Van Horn; Council members Shelley Brophy, Roy Boldon, Mike Keller and David Norton; City Manager Jim Jeffers, City Attorney Rob Atherton and City Secretary Jan Vinson.

Mayor Van Horn called meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

2. Items to be removed from Consent Agenda.

B. Consider approval of Market Place II (Hauck Holdings) easement.

Council member Keller moved to approve consent agenda as presented. Motion seconded by Council member Boldon and unanimously passed.

REGULAR AGENDA:

4. <u>PUBLIC HEARING:</u> Consider request for zoning change from A, Agricultural, to R-4, Multi-Family Residential, for Lots 2-C and 2-D, City Block 65, located at Durst and Harris Streets. Request initiated by Terry Singleton. ZON2015-003.

Municipal Services Director Larissa Philpot presented a request for zone change for property on the corner of Durst and Harris Streets owned by Terry Singleton (1021 East Austin). Mr. Singleton wishes to subdivide the property, currently zoned agricultural, into several lots and the subdivision plat has been filed. The proposed zoning change would allow single family or multi family structures. The Planning and Zoning Commission recently met and recommends approval of said zoning change. Mr. Singleton gave a brief report of his plans for the property. No one else wished to speak for or against the zoning change. Mayor Van Horn closed the public hearing.

Council member Norton moved to approve zoning change as presented. Motion seconded by Council member Boldon and unanimously passed.

5. Consider resolution nominating a member(s) to the Nacogdoches Central Appraisal District Board of Directors.

City Manager Jim Jeffers explained that each year the City nominates an individual or individuals to serve on the Central Appraisal District Board of Directors. Mayor Van Horn currently serves on said board and expressed an interest in continuing to serve. Council member Brophy moved to nominate Mayor Roger Van Horn to serve on the Central Appraisal District Board of Directors. Motion seconded by Council member Norton and unanimously passed.

6. Consider ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1680-9-14 appropriating various amounts in accordance with budget adoption for fiscal year beginning October 1, 2014 and ending September 30, 2015.

Amending Ordinance No. 1680-9-14 is the last item to close out fiscal year 2014/2015. Pam Curbow, Finance Director, stated this is a normal process the City goes through reviewing accounts over/under budget from the previous year appropriating various amounts to close out the fiscal year. Council member Keller requested information on legal services of law suit in the utility fund. City Attorney Rob Atherton reported the legal services were regarding provision of some equipment at the City's waste water plant that was deemed defective.

Council member Brophy moved to amend Ordinance No. 1680-9-14 as presented. Motion seconded by Council member Boldon and unanimously passed.

7. Presentation on annexation.

Municipal Services Director Larissa Philpot discussed annexation information in regard to the northern end of city limits on North Street which will be presented in a formal annexation process in the future. Mayor Van Horn reminded the audience this was an information session and not an open meeting therefore residents of said area would not be speaking for/against Item 7. There will be ample opportunity for public comment in future meetings.

8. Update on Ethics and Conflict of Interest Rules and Legislation.

City Attorney Rob Atherton presented updates on Local Government Code Chapter 171 Regulating Conflicts of Interest and Chapter 176 Disclosure of Certain Relationships.

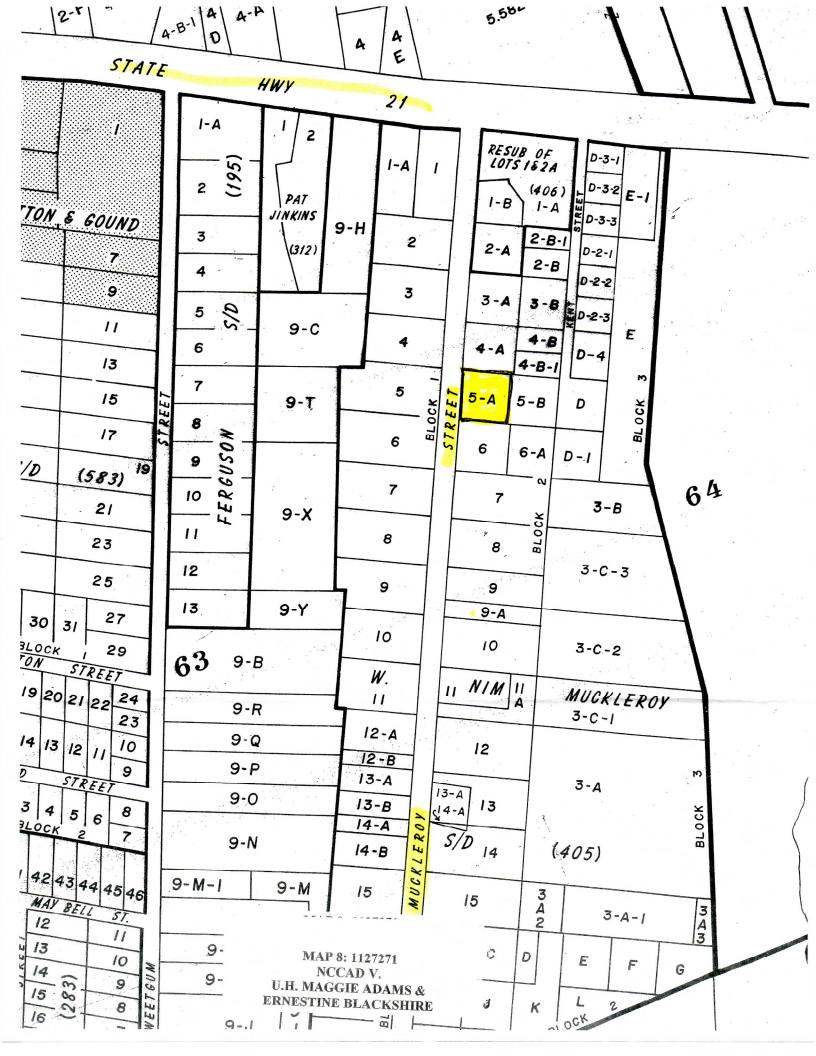

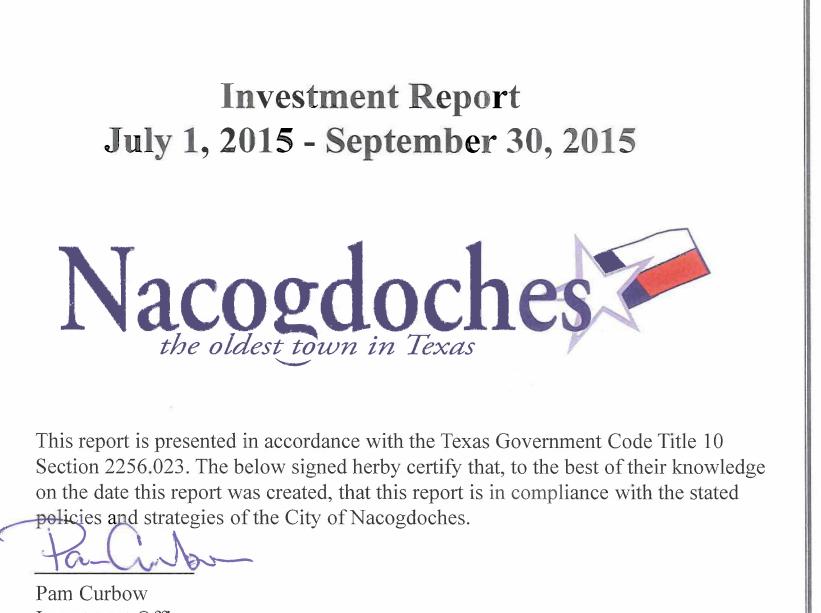

Investment Position City of Nacogdoches September 30, 2015

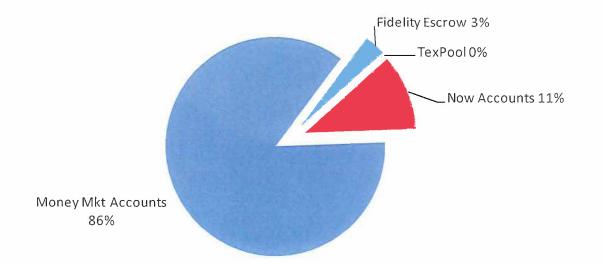
As of September 30, 2015, the City of Nacogdoches had a total of \$5 million in non-interest bearing NOW Accounts at Regions Bank, \$38.2 million invested in Money Market accounts earning a contracted rate of 0.55%, and \$1.4 million in a Fidelity Money Market Escrow account earning a rate of 0.01%. The City's average yield for FY15 is 0.31%.

The City did not have any money invested in Treasuries, Bonds, or other investments with a stated maturity date.

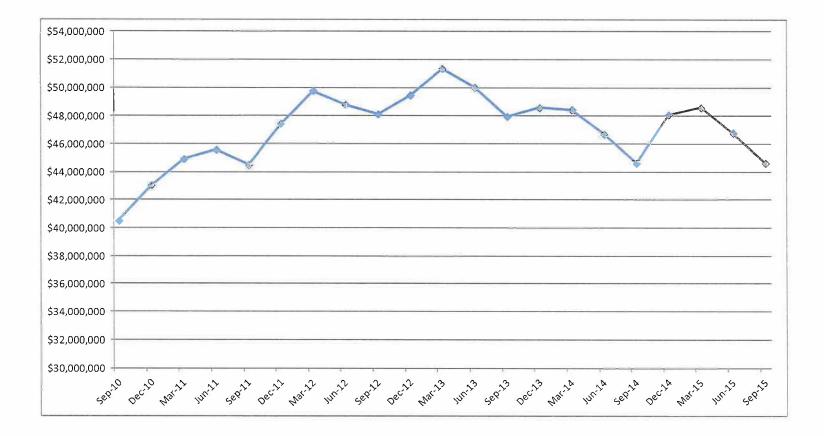

PROJECT: Consider payment to Nacogdoches Convention and Visitors Bureau for website upgrade.

- MEETING DATE: November 3, 2015
- DESCRIPTION: Nacogdoches Convention and Visitors Bureau approved a Destination Vision Plan in 2014. In order to maximize market share from the hospitality industry and compete with other destinations, the Nacogdoches tourism industry requires a more sophisticated website. The website upgrade will assist the CVB in tracking leads, securing potential businesses and providing accountability on definitive business and visitors.

The CVB recommends Simpleview, LLC. to administer the website upgrade as they currently provide services to over 80% of the convention and visitor bureaus in the Nation.

COST: \$75,000

The Nacogdoches Convention and Visitors Bureau completed a Destination Vision Plan in 2014. Through extensive research it was determined that in order to maximize market share from the hospitality industry and compete with other destinations, the Nacogdoches tourism industry required a more sophisticated website. A new website will provide the visitor with a roadmap to capture those experiences and sell them on the "must see" in Nacogdoches. Finally, the website will give the Bureau the ability to track leads and secure potential business as well as provide much needed accountability on definitive business and visitors secured by the CVB.

The selected vendor is called Simpleview. This company currently provides services to over 80% of the convention and visitor bureaus in the Nation and only work within the tourism industry. Consequently, they understand the tourism business and integrate the destination data obtained through the website with established industry calculators and analytical processes. The Nacogdoches CVB will be able to establish economic impacts and measure true progress through these systems.

The Destination Vision Study noted that the website upgrade was one of the most important strategies that will move the destination forward.

- PROJECT: Consider selection and award of a Professional Engineering Contract to Schaumburg & Polk, Inc. (SPI) for the design of several sanitary sewer projects.
- MEETING DATE: November 3, 2015
- DESCRIPTION: SPI will be tasked with surveying and engineering design for replacement of the City's main sanitary sewer line along North Street from Magnolia Court Assisted Living to Rose Lake Boulevard, which has failed and is experiencing frequent collapses and blockages. SPI will also provide bid plans for a new sewer extension along North Stallings Drive to serve the new Travel Plaza & Denny's that was part of our 380 agreement with the developer. These projects are expected to have a construction cost of approximately \$550,000.

SPI has been selected by a staff committee, based letter of interest proposals submitted in July 2013. SPI has worked with the City of Nacogdoches for over 30 years on various utility projects. This contract will include fees for the preliminary design, final design, bid contract documents, bid administration, and construction phases of the project excluding detailed inspection which will be performed mostly by City staff.
