ON 02-16-16 AT APPROXIMATELY 0242 HOURS, NCSO DEPUTIES INITIATED A TRAFFIC STOP ON A PASSENGER VEHICLE IN THE 3000 BLOCK OF SOUTH ST. DEPUTIES MADE CONTACT WITH THE OCCUPANTS, WHO APPEARED EXTREMELY NERVOUS AND UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF NARCOTICS. DEPUTIES OBSERVED A STRONG ODOR OF MARIJUANA EMITTING FROM THE VEHICLE. A PROBABLE CAUSE SEARCH OF THE VEHICLE WAS CONDUCTED. A PLASTIC BAGGY CONTAINING ILLICIT NARCOTICS WAS LOCATED INSIDE OF THE VEHICLE, ALONG WITH DRUG PARAPHERNALIA.
