Mayor Pro Tem Shelley Brophy, Roy Boldon, David Norton and Mike Keller, City Attorney Jeff Davis.

Mayor Roger Van Horn excused absence.

- 1. Mayor Pro Tem Brophy called meeting to order at 5:34 p.m.
- 2. Open Forum.

Opportunity was given for individuals to participate in open forum. No comments from the general public were received.

3. Items to be removed from Consent Agenda.

None.

- 4. <u>CONSENT AGENDA:</u> Items included under Consent Agenda require little or no deliberation by Council. Approval of Consent Agenda authorizes the City Manager or his designee to proceed with conclusion of each in accordance with staff recommendations as reflected in the minutes of this meeting.
 - A. Consider approval of minutes from February 16, 2015 regular session.

Council Member Norton moved to approve consent agenda as presented. Motion seconded by Council Member Boldon and unanimously passed.

REGULAR AGENDA:

5. Nacogdoches Convention and Visitors Bureau Quarterly Report.

Nacogdoches CVB Executive Director Carl Watson presented quarterly report for first quarter of current fiscal year to include economic impact, hotel occupancy tax receipts, website redesign, personnel, new accounting system, events, financials, tourism and marketing. The CVB continues progress on new website redesign and rebranding, anticipating completion by the beginning of summer 2016. Mr. Watson reported hotel occupancy tax increased 8% in 2015 over 2014 and supplied financial reports to City Council using the CVB's new accounting system showing balance sheet and profit/loss statements.

No action necessary.

6. Consider approval for purchase of Cat 963 Track-loader for the Landfill.

Public Works Manager Cary Walker requested approval to purchase a new track-loader for the landfill which will replace a 2010 track-loader. \$340,000 was budgeted for this item and cost of new track-loader is \$336,209 with a savings of \$3,741.

Council Member Boldon made a motion to approve purchase of the track-loader as presented. Motion seconded by Council Member Keller and passed unanimously.

7. Consider approval for purchase of new public safety radio system.

Police Chief Jim Sevey discussed possible acquisition of new public safety radio system administered by Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA). The estimated cost of the City's portion of this project is \$1,655,488 and the monthly operating fees are set at \$8,075. The City and County continue to discuss opportunities for the County to take part in this project.

Larry Brown, Lower Colorado River Authority, discussed the history of LCRA and how they got involved in public safety radio systems.

City Manager Jim Jeffers presented funding options to City Council. The City's policy states the Reserve Fund Balance must not drop below twenty five percent. If the proposed public safety radio system is purchased with Reserve Fund Balance money that fund would drop below the policy threshold. Mr. Jeffers presented one option might be to borrow money on a seven year note which will have a debt service of approximately \$300,000 per year, an estimated interest rate of 1.750% (by First Southwest Securities) and an issuance cost of \$40,000 which could require tax rate increase of \$.02 to service.

Mike Butchko, citizen of Nacogdoches, spoke in favor of purchasing the new radio system.

8. Consider approval of 2016 TxDOT – Aviation Capital Improvement Program Grant project for airport perimeter fencing.

Airport Manager Mary Uresti presented resolution for approval of proposed grant project for perimeter fencing (38,000 linear feet of game fencing) at the airport. Total cost of the project is \$719,977 with the City's portion being \$71,998 which is budgeted.

Council Member Keller made a motion to approve airport perimeter fencing by resolution as presented. Motion seconded by Council Member Norton and passed unanimously.

City Council went into Executive Session at 6:33 p.m.



SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: SFA requested a 10-foot-wide, 480-foot-long easement and Right-of-Way located across Lot 16 of City Block 95 through Consolidated Communications. This will cross the western portion of the Baseball and Softball Complex on Northwest Stallings Drive. The Right-of-Way will be for underground fiber optic line to the SFA Baseball locker room. This will have minimal impact on the City property and staff. It is recommended the easement be donated and all other costs be paid by SFA. ITEM/SUBJECT: Consider purchase of 2,380 cubic yards of reclaimed asphalt pavement material from Texas Department of Transportation.

SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: Requesting approval for bulk purchase of approximately 2,380 cubic yards of Reclaimed Asphalt Pavement (RAP) material from the Texas Department of Transportation, for a total of \$50,000. Reclaimed asphalt is material that has been milled off existing roadways and is useful as a good surfacing alternative for gravel pavement locations such as parking lots and trails. RAP can replace more expensive gravel pavements typically used for plant access roads, water well driveways, lift station sites and maintenance areas. City crews typically purchase limestone gravel or crushed concrete on an as-needed basis to use in these areas. This bulk purchase from TxDOT will allow the City to stockpile material for use all year, which is especially helpful for afterhours emergency repairs when normal gravel delivery is not available. The cost for RAP from TxDOT is \$21 per ton, which can be as much as half the cost of commercially purchased gravel.

The purchase of the reclaimed asphalt is being split between two budget categories with \$28,000 coming from budgeted funds for Park Improvements and the remaining \$22,000 coming from Street Capital funds.
