

Freedom Fest 2018 in Downtown Nacogdoches

Fourth of July Fun & Fireworks

NACOGDOCHES – Games, music, water slides, food and fireworks will all be at this year's Freedom Fest

2018, which is set for July 4th in Festival Park near downtown Nacogdoches. The Nacogdoches Jaycees and the City of Nacogdoches are planning for this annual family event to be the biggest yet, with a fireworks show that will be higher in the sky than ever before.

Community members will be able to compete in a Washers Tournament or a Chipotle Burrito Eating Contest.
