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Día de Muertos: Altar Foods

(Nacogdoches, TX) – In anticipation of this year's Día de Muertos Fiesta, librarian Mercedes Franks will lead a workshop on making chicken posole, a traditional Mexican dish. While there are many different foods and traditions associated with Día de Muertos, a common practice is to leave the deceased person's favorite dish next to the ofrenda (altar) that has been built to remember them. Participants will learn to make a slightly updated version of the chicken posole recipe.
