Art, services, and other generously donated items will be on offer, with 100% of proceeds going to survivors of the Caddo Mounds tornado. "This event was always planned to be a celebration of our close-knit community and all the unique features that make us special," says Hicks. "Now, that will only be more poignant and meaningful. We are a resilient community, and we are there for our neighbors, whether supporting local businesses or offering assistance when tragedy strikes."
