A.A.R.P. Offers Free Tax Preparation at the Public Library

(Nacogdoches, TX) – Free tax preparation will be offered by AARP Tax-Aide volunteers at the Nacogdoches Public Library on Mondays beginning February 3rd through April 6th. Sessions will be from 9am to 11:30 am on a first-come, first-serve basis. AARP can help individuals and families file most tax returns. There are no age or income restrictions to receive this service. However, participants must come prepared with photo I.D., social security card for everyone on the tax return, all W-2s, 1099s, other tax receipts, voided check or deposit slip and last year's tax return.

“We are very appreciative of these volunteers. They undergo vigorous training and give much of their time to assist others. Their work is invaluable for many people who cannot afford a paid tax service,” said Mercedes Franks, library director.
