**Census Job Fair at the Public Library**

(Nacogdoches, TX) – The counting period for the 2020 U.S. census will begin in mid-March and the U.S. Census Bureau is hiring for many positions in our area to ensure that everyone is counted. The Nacogdoches Public Library and U.S. Census Bureau will host a job fair on Tuesday, February 18th from 12:30-3:30 pm.

U.S. Census Recruiter Lisa Sands will be on hand to answer basic questions about the types of job opportunities available. For those people who are interested in applying for a census job, but cannot attend the fair, they may apply directly at [2020census.gov/jobs](https://2020census.gov/jobs).

“We are very pleased to facilitate the census job fair and all other efforts to ensure that we get an accurate count of our community. The public library has free computers for job seekers to complete job applications, whether with the Census Bureau or another employer. The library and recreation center building also offers free wi-fi throughout the building. And later when the counting period opens, the public may use our computers or

wi-fi to complete their census form if they prefer to do it online. Of course, the census form can also be completed by phone or by mail.” said Mercedes Franks, library director.
