**ORDER TERMINATING RESTRICTION ON OUTDOOR BURNING**

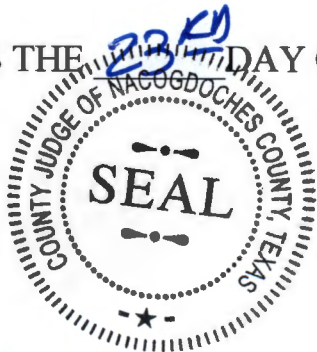
**WHEREAS**, on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2022, the Commissioners Court of Nacogdoches County, Texas found that circumstances were present in all or part of the unincorporated area of the county that created a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and


**WHEREAS**, The County Commissioners Court issued an order restricting outdoor burning in the unincorporated area of the county for 90 days, unless restrictions are terminated based on a determination made by the Court or the County Judge that the circumstances that require this order no longer exist; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that the circumstances that require an order to restrict outdoor burning in Nacogdoches County no longer exist.


