On or about 1540, 01 October 2025, Officer KILLINGSWORTH was contacted via telephone by administrative staff at Thomas J Rusk Elementary and his presence was requested due to unruly parents/grandparents on site. Officer KILLINGSWORTH arrived in a marked patrol vehicle to the front of the school and as he approached the front doors observed two females standing there. One of the females, the younger of the two, he recognized from an incident the week prior. KILLINGSWORTH made entry into the school and contacted school Principal PAULA HARSHBARGER and her staff in the main office. There was no commotion or activity at that time between the parties.

HARSHBARGER explained that the mother of two of her former students (identified as KOLONDR A CURL) had returned after withdrawing her children the week prior with her mother (identified as PAULETTER CURL) and the two were attempting to re-enroll the students and demanding to meet face-to-face with the Administrative staff at that moment. They had been advised that it was near the end of the school day, and that all staff were busy getting ready for the dismissal of the large student body in a few minutes. The normal procedure is to fill out a "concern form" and that it would be forwarded to the staff and a member of such would contact them for an appointment to meet about their concerns. Both of the CURL subjects refused to fill out the form and demanded to see administrative staff immediately. Allegedly, PAULETTER CURL had pointed her finger at one of the staff and demanded in a stern and aggressive tone the staff do what they say, that they would not fill out any more paperwork and would speak to someone "right now". After refusing to follow the procedures and rules for such, the staff felt concerned and uneasy...then contacted KILLINGSWORTH for assistance.

Officer KILLINGSWORTH then activated his body camera and went out front to meet with the CURL ladies concerning the matter. A discussion ensued concerning the fact that they were upset about the staff and wanted to speak with the Principal immediately. KILLINGSWORTH passed on to PAULETTER CURL that the staff was busy and tied up at the moment and that there was a procedure that would be followed in order to voice their concerns with the staff. PAULETTER CURL repeatedly told her daughter KOLONDR A CURL (mother of the two former students) not to speak and interrupted her repeatedly. The discussion did not move from that point. KILLINGSWORTH repeated what HARSHBARGER had told him and explained the procedure and offered the "Concern Form" to her, which she refused to take. This happened two more times, still no progress. KILLINGSWORTH then placed the "Concern Form" on the table next to CURL and said "I'll just leave this here for you" as he did so. CURL retrieved the form from the table and tore it into four pieces, placing them into a trash can. KILLINGSWORTH advised CURL that there would be no meeting today. Near the end of the conversation, PAULETTER CURL advised KILLINGSWORTH about a matter from the previous week between KILLINGSWORTH and KOLONDR A CURL, where she had been advised not to use aggressive tones and obscene language in or around the school or towards school

staff. PAULETTER CURL advised KILLINGSWORTH that her daughter (KOLONDRAL CURL) could use whatever tone and language she chose as her right as a mother. KILLINGSWORTH advised not on this campus or towards this staff. CURL replied 'Its Free Speech, she can if she wants to'. KILLINGSWORTH said "No, its only free speech until it offends someone". CURL wanted to argue and KILLINGSWORTH refused.

After taking down the OFFICERS name and badge number, making sure who he worked for and taking a very nice picture of him, the two departed from the landing of the school entry and advised KILLINGSWORTH that he would be out of a job and PAULETTER CURL would have his badge by the end of the day as they walked to their car and drove away.
