On November 8, 2025, deputies responded to a complaint from a tenant alleging that her landlord had disconnected the water and power utilities prior to her move-out. The landlord was contacted by phone and stated that the disconnection occurred because the utility bills had not been paid, not due to any intentional action on his part. Deputies informed the landlord that the intentional disconnection of utilities to force a tenant to vacate the property constitutes constructive eviction, a prohibited practice under tenant protection laws. The landlord claimed he had been told by a court that if he didn't pay the bills to the utilities then they can shut it off; however, deputies clarified that such, did not legally permit him to take such action. The landlord was advised to restore the utilities immediately and reminded of the potential civil penalties for violating tenant rights.
