On 12/01/2025, at approximately 05:58, deputies were dispatched to the 14000 block of State Highway 21W in reference to a reckless driver. The caller reported that the vehicle was swerving in and out of its lane and driving erratically, creating a potential hazard to other motorists. Deputies located the described vehicle and observed the driver fail to maintain a single lane of traffic, deputies conducted a traffic stop for the offence. The vehicle and its driver were contacted on Loop 224, near the Expo. Upon making contact with the driver, deputies determined that the operator, an elderly female, was disoriented and lost while attempting to follow GPS directions. The driver was visibly upset and crying, expressing concern about her inability to find her way home. After assessing the situation and ensuring the driver's safety, deputies issued a warning for the traffic violation. Deputies then provided assistance to the driver so she could get back to her residence located on University Drive. Deputies cleared the scene and returned to service.
