On 01/27/2026 at approximately 0900 hours, deputies were conducting routine patrols on county roadways following a recent major winter ice storm that

impacted East Texas, causing severe damage, roadway debris, and widespread power outages throughout the county. Deputies were actively assisting residents, conducting welfare checks, and clearing debris and other roadway hazards.

While traveling on a county roadway, a low-lying power line, which had been pulled down due to storm-related damage, snagged the passenger-side light bar of Unit 37, forcibly ripping the light bar from its mounted position. As a result of the incident, minor damage was also sustained to the vehicle.

No injuries were reported. Unit 37 was later transported to the department shop located at 2306 Douglas Road, where repairs were completed. After repairs were made, Unit 37 was placed back into service.

The winter ice storm caused some residences in the area to be without electrical power for extended periods exceeding 90 hours, contributing to hazardous roadway conditions throughout the county.

Photographs of the damage to Unit 37 will be attached to this report for documentation purposes.

Deputies resumed patrol and assistance operations following the incident.
